With that goal in mind, we're striving for everyone to feel good in spirit, mind, and body. One of the health issues for awareness in September Youth Suicide Prevention and September 10 is Youth Suicide Prevention Day. This day serves to promote the understanding and prevention of suicide and support those who are affected by it worldwide. According to the most recent data available, suicide is in the top 10 causes of death for adults and the second leading cause of death in youth ages 15-24 years old. In 2016 nearly 45,000 individuals died by suicide.
